Minutes

President Mark Neale called the meeting of the Historical Society of West Point to order at 3:00 p.m., January 18, 2009. Reverend Bill Palmer gave the opening prayer. Dr. Richard Hosfield gave the Treasurers Report: Funds in the amount of \$10,000 have been received from the Friends of the Library and the money is now in the bank in the museum account. The total in the general account is \$13,109.39. Dues are now being accepted for the new year.

The October 19, 2008 meeting minutes were read and accepted as recorded by Sandra Willis for Juanita Cawley. The term tower was clarified to mean the communications tower.

It was reported that the Friends of the Library have a fund of \$10,000 earmarked for a museum for the Historical Society of West Point.

Sandra Willis reported on the results of the first historical walking tour sponsored by the Society. There were a handful of participants, likely due to the very cold temperatures. The activity will be reassessed for the future. Sandra also reported that all the paperwork had been completed for the 5013c and our status is official.

John Lee announced the nominations for officers for next year: Ty Bland, President, Cathy Price for Vice President, Richard Hosfield, Treasurer and Juanita Cawley, Secretary. The slated will be voted on at the next quarterly meeting.

Revered Palmer presented an interesting lecture, The Five Myths about West Point, which was well received.
The meeting was adjourned at 4:03 p.m. and refreshments were served.
