

**HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF WEST POINT  
BOARD MEETING**

September 8, 2008

The meeting was opened by President Mark Neale at 7:30 PM. Mrs. Juanita Cawley read the minutes from the June 2, 2008 Board meeting. They were approved with corrections. Dr. Richard Hosfield provided the Treasurer's report. The current treasury balanced was reported as \$2251.37.

Committee Chairmen reports were received. Publication chairman, Reverend Bill Palmer reported that the next newsletter will be for October and the topic will be Port Richmond. The cost will be approximately \$800. Public Relations Chairman, Jim Dopp was reported to have withdrawn from the board due to health reasons. A replacement is needed. Museum Chairman, Avie Williams reported that the old Parks and Recreation building where the museum will be temporarily housed needs landscaping and other upgrades. A report must be made to Council since the Town owns the property. It was decided that Mark Neale will present the report to Council. A report will be brought back to the Board in December. Cathy Price, Membership Chairman reported that the HSWP had a booth at the Chesty Puller race. Three new members have joined since July. Connie Peay, Crab Carnival Chairman reported that there will be a HSWP information booth at Crab Carnival.

In old business, discussion of sidewalk markers continued from the last meeting. A report will be brought before the community development committee of town council for approval. A report will be given to the Board at the December meeting.

In new business it was decided that Sandra Willis, Will Addison and Beverly Branch will spearhead a walking tour as an activity during Christmas on the Town, December 7.

Minutes of the meetings will be posted on the website. They will also be sent to Board members prior to the meeting.

It was decided that the Board will meet the fourth Tuesday of November.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
